

Rutledge U.S. Senate Campaign Releases Statement on Filing FEC Quarterly Report

(Maryland) -- In accordance with federal law, U.S. Senate Candidate for Maryland, Jim Rutledge, has filed the required campaign financial statement with the Federal Elections Commission (FEC). While FEC quarterly reports provide value in bringing transparency to bear in elections, they do not tell the whole story.
